Japan and South Korea are the Most Popular Travel Spots for Post-outbreak among Citizens

Travel Fair ITE survey received 1,506 replies from Hong Kong people who indicated where they would like to visit after travel restriction lifted. Chosen by some 70 percent respondents, Japan and South Korea are the most popular destination. Next at some 40 percent are the neighbouring areas, where likely be the earliest to have border control relaxed. In particular, Taiwan gain some 6 percent to around 43 percent this year. 
Hong Kong and United Arab Emirates Sign Investment Promotion and Protection Agreement
